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X. ITEMS FOR DISCUSSION

Update Council on outstanding items.

Parking in Yards - Shirley Jaster updated the city council by stating that a briefing item is planned to be presented to the city council at the February 24, 2014 council meeting. The briefing item will be scheduled for the full two-month transparency process permitting ample time for the public to provide input for city council consideration. She also reported that all exiting notes and research on the matter will be compiled into a single PDF file and forwarded in advance to council members permitting individual council members to familiarize themselves with the research at their own pace.

Donation/Collection Bins - Shirley Jaster reported that she has coordinated with the Arkansas staff and that there is a plan to roll out a proposed ordinance in each jurisdiction simultaneously.

to the respective Planning and Zoning Commissions. It is anticipated that a city council briefing item will be presented at the March 10, 2014 meeting.

Animal Shelter - Craig Lindholm reported that the staff continues to evaluate the cost associated with using the Texarkana, Arkansas animal shelter and that the annual costs appear to be escalating. There has been no discussion concerning renewing or updating the current contract between Texarkana, Texas and Texarkana, Arkansas. Staff continues to review plans and designs of recently constructed or soon to be constructed animal shelters in Texas. There is an option, should the Council desire, to have some design firms make presentations to Council.

Temporary Tents at Business Locations - Shirley Jaster reported that a briefing item will be presented at the February 24, 2014 council meeting proposing changes to the city ordinances that regulate the use of tents at business locations.

Boards & Commissions - City Manager Whitson reported that he and the city secretary have researched creation documents for city commissions, boards, and committees and continue to research similar documents for outside agencies where the city appoints members to their governing boards. As a first step the staff has redesigned the Excel file used to track membership. The new design will quickly identify any appointment that will expire within 90 days and also further identify by color code any appointments that have expired. The 90-day notice will permit the city secretary to advertise pending vacancies thus seek applications from interested citizens who want to be considered for appointment. Mr. Whitson stated that he is drafting a policy for council consideration that will be intended to improve the transparency of the appointment process. He expects to have a briefing item ready in March 2014.

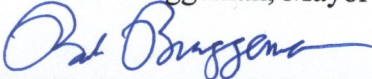

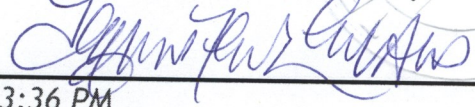
